1. What are cookies?

Skapa uses 'cookies' to facilitate and improve your online experience and to personalize the content of the website to your needs and preferences. Also known as browser cookie or tracking cookie, a cookie is a small, often encrypted text file that is placed on your hard disk by a Web server. Cookies are not used to run programs or deliver viruses to your computer. Cookies are uniquely assigned to you and can only be read by a web server in the domain that issued the cookie to you. The purpose of a cookie is to tell the Web server that you have returned to a specific page. When you return to the same website, the information you previously provided can be retrieved, so you can easily use the customized features. So, cookies are used by web developers to help users navigate the website efficiently and perform certain functions.

2. What type of cookies are used?

The website of Skapa uses different kinds of cookies. The table below explains which cookies we use and what their purpose is:

Necessary cookies:

Necessary cookies help make a website usable by enabling basic functions like page navigation and access to secure areas of the website. The website cannot function properly without these cookies.

Type	Purpose	Duration
laravel_session	This cookie is used internally by the website's owners, when uploading or renewing website content.	6 days
XSRF-TOKEN	Ensures visitor browsing -security by preventing cross-site request forgery. This cookie is essential for the security of the website and visitor.	6 days
cookielawinfo-checkbox-non-necessary	Determines whether the visitor has accepted the cookie consent box.	1 year
elementor	WordPress page builder used to construct the website.	Persistent

Preference cookies:

Preference cookies enable a website to remember information that changes the way the website behaves or looks, like your preferred language or the region that you are in.

Type	Purpose	Duration
Wh-widget-cookie	Necessary for the functionality of the website's chat-box function.	1 day

Marketing cookies:

Marketing cookies are used to track visitors across websites. The intention is to display ads that are relevant and engaging for the individual user and thereby more valuable for publishers and third-party advertisers.

Type	Purpose	Duration
GPS	Registers a unique ID on mobile devices to enable tracking based on geographical GPS location.	1 day
IDE	Used by Google DoubleClick to register and report the website user's actions after viewing or clicking one of the advertiser's ads with the purpose of measuring the efficacy of an ad and to present targeted ads to the user.	1 year
Test-cookie	Used to check if the user's browser supports cookies.	1 day
VISITOR_INFO1_LIVE	Tries to estimate the user's bandwidth on pages with integrated YouTube videos.	179 days
YSC	Registers a unique ID to keep statistics of what videos from YouTube the user has seen.	Session
Yt-remote-cast-installed	Stores the user's video player preferences using embedded YouTube video.	Session
Yt-remote-connected-devices	Stores the user's video player preferences using embedded YouTube video.	Persistent
Yt-remote-device-id	Stores the user's video player preferences using embedded YouTube video.	Persistent
Yt-remote-fast-check-period	Stores the user's video player preferences using embedded YouTube video.	Session
Yt-remote-session-app	Stores the user's video player preferences using embedded YouTube video.	Session
Yt-remote-session-name	Stores the user's video player preferences using embedded YouTube video.	Session
